

King-Danforth Elementary Unified Dress Code

How we dress does matter. Students enrolled at King-Danforth Elementary School shall abide by the following unified dress code:

PANTS & SLACKS

COLORS: PLAIN TAN KHAKI, NAVY OR BLACK PANTS

- Pants must fit at the natural waistline or no lower than two inches below the waist.
- Hip huggers and low rider pants are not allowed.
- Pants must be of an appropriate size.
- All pants must be worn with a belt if belt loops are present.
- **Cargo pants are not permitted.**
- **Blue jeans will not be permitted.**

DRESSES AND JUMPERS

COLORS: PLAIN TAN KHAKI, NAVY OR BLACK

- No more than two inches above the knee with no splits, slits or openings.
- Pleated dresses and jumpers are permitted.
- Jumpers must be worn with blouses, polo shirts, or turtlenecks.

SKIRTS

COLORS: PLAIN TAN KHAKI, NAVY OR BLACK

- No more than two inches above the knee with no splits, slits, or openings.
- Pleated skirts are acceptable.

SHORTS, SKORTS AND CAPRIS

COLORS: PLAIN TAN KHAKI, NAVY OR BLACK

- They must be of appropriate size. See requires for pants and slacks as it relates to fit.

POLO SHIRTS

COLORS: PLAIN WHITE, NAVY BLUE OR GOLD

- Shirts may be long or short sleeves and must be tucked in.

BLOUSES

- Blouses with collars are permitted and must be tucked in.

SCHOOL T-SHIRTS OR SCHOOL SWEAT SHIRTS ARE PERMITTED DAILY

- School T-shirts are permitted and must be tucked in.

SWEATERS/CARDIGANS/VESTS/SWEAT SHIRTS

PLAIN WHITE, NAVY BLUE AND GOLD

- They must be appropriately sized and do not have to be tucked in.

TENNIS/ATHLETIC SHOES

- Black or White
- With properly sized shoe laces.
- All shoes must be laced, tied and/or fastened appropriately.
- **Dark soft-soled shoes** are preferred.
- Students must wear socks or hose with all shoes.
- Socks must be black or white when visible.
- All shoes must have full backs and enclosed toes.
- Sandals and backless shoes are not permitted.

BELTS (Black or Brown) must be worn with all pants/skirts caprice and skorts, if belt loops are present.

HAIR

Hair color, hair style, bows, barrettes and hair bands must not call undue attention to the student.

HYGIENE

Each student must maintain desirable personal hygiene so as not to be offensive to others. *(Turn Page Over)*

ITEMS NOT PERMITTED:

Clothing with frayed ends, holes, fading and camouflage, Cargo pants and other clothing with large pocket will not be permitted. Student undergarment should not be visible. Inappropriately sized clothing, layering of shirts, big shirts will not be permitted. Caps, hats, hoods, bandannas, scarves and do-rags worn on the head inside the building will not be permitted. Combs, picks, roach clips and curlers may not be worn in the hair. Cell phones, beepers and pagers will not be permitted. Removable ornamental tooth caps will not be permitted. Shoes with wheels, games and other toys will not be permitted.

NON-PERMITTED CLOTHING ITEMS Standard for all Bibb County schools as well as King-Danforth
(This is not intended as a comprehensive list of non-permitted clothing items)

Any camouflage-type clothing
Tank tops, muscle shirts
Layering of t-shirts
Bib overalls
Big Shirts, jerseys or other oversized shirts which cannot be tucked in
Spandex, athletic style or cut off shorts
Baggy pants or shorts
Hats
Pagers
Sweat pants, fleece pants
Games, toys
Sleeveless shirts or blouses
See through, low cut or skin tight clothing
Flip flops; soccer sandals
Shoes with wheels
Inappropriately sized clothing
Sunglasses
Dice, playing cards

Also:
Symbols which may be offensive or disrupt the orderly operation of the school and/or activities including swastikas and gang-related clothing

Any article of clothing which advertises alcohol, drugs, sex, or which contains inflammatory, vulgar, lewd or suggestive writing, pictures or emblems. Any clothing which advertises or advocates the use of a product prohibited on school premises. Any clothing which disrupts the learning process.

Hats, caps, hoods, scarves, bandannas or "do rags" worn on the head inside the building. Combs, picks, pencils, roach clips, and curlers may not be worn in the hair. Possession of metal picks is prohibited on school property.

Any object or ornament that is distracting or that is capable of being used as a weapon or in the use of drugs or alcohol.

Facial and or body ornaments(i.e., tongue rings, nose rings, eye studs, removable ornamental tooth/teeth caps, etc.) including face painting, glitter, body jewelry, temporary tattoos or other adornment that calls undue attention to the wearer.

All other items which, in the judgment of the principal (designee), disrupt or distract from the teaching and learning process.

Each school administration may establish variations to these requirements in response to identified needs. All such variations must be approved by the Board Of Education and be communicated to students and parents by the school.
