Dress Code 2011-12 School Year

- Khaki (tan or beige), navy, or black pants, walking shorts, capris, skirts, skorts, or jumpers. All pants must be plain (unembellished, no cargo pockets), non-faded, with no holes or fraying, fitted at the waist and appropriate in length (cannot touch the floor). Skirts, skorts, and jumpers may be no shorter than 2" above the knee.
- Plain (unembellished), solid red, navy, light blue and white turtle necks or collared shirts with sleeves containing no logos or designs except the school logo or crest.
- Shirts **MUST** be able to be tucked into pants or skirts with no discomfort or bulging.
- Belts **MUST** be worn if there are belt loops.
- Socks or tights must be worn.
- Shoes must be solid black, white, or brown with closed toes and backs and **NO HEEL**. Laces must be tied at all times.
- Hats, caps, hoods, bandannas, and scarves may not be worn on the head while in the building (unless worn for religious purposes).
- Jeans and school t-shirts may be worn for special occasions.
- Items not permitted in the Bibb County dress code will not be permitted in the unified dress policy at L.H. Williams Elementary School.
